



Our school's sponsoring body, the nonprofit-making Yau Ma Tei Kaifong Association, established Yaumati Kaifong Association School as an aided school in Yau Ma Tei in 1968. The foundation stone of the building was laid in August 1967 and work was completed for the school to open in 1968. The school catered for local students from 1968 until 1997 when it was forced to close due to falling enrollments.

However, due to the concerted efforts and beliefs of the sponsoring body and the school supervisor, the school was reinstated by the Education Department to reopen in 1998. During this new phase the school operated six classes for Chinese speaking students and six classes in English to cater for ethnic minority students from the surrounding area.

In 2003, work commenced under the government funding to build additional rooms that would offer a visual arts room, school library, music room and a multimedia learning center, the school was then able to offer a higher standard of education for its students. During this time period, the demographics of the surrounding area had changed and the enrollment of ethnic minority students was increasing. In 2006 to 2007 academic year, the school was identified as one of the designated schools catering for non-Chinese





students in Hong Kong. In 2008 to 2009 academic year, all twelve classes were operating in English as the medium of instruction.

From 2011, with sponsorships from the benefactors in the community, our performing arts room was newly established, language room and computer room was modernized and all computers were upgraded to offer better I.T lessons to our students. Currently the school has an enrolment of over 400 students operating in 12 classes.

The school is always sensitive to the changes in education reforms and plays an active role in the affairs and events of the local community. The school stresses the importance of unity, harmony and respect as the cornerstone of learning for all students. We place the interest and needs of the students and parents as the paramount focus of the school. The school is able to achieve these foci through the leadership of the School Management Committee, the School Principal and the dedication of the school teachers and support staff.

Chinese

Our school collaboratively with the School-based Support section of EDB and used the "EDB Chinese Language Curriculum Second Language Learning Framework" to develop our P. 1 – P. 6 school-based curriculum and the Chinese Layered-teaching Activities. These not only cater for students' learning needs, but also to arouse our students' interests and abilities in learning Chinese.

On the other hand, our school provides different learning programmes to enhance students' learning abilities in Chinese such as "Summer Bridging course", "Chinese Culture Day", "Chinese story-telling" etc. Furthermore, our school provides different experiences in aspects of main stream Chinese culture, through visiting Hong Kong Palace Museum and Organizing activities such as Lion Dance, Chinese Dance, Chinese calligraphy competition, Chinese Speech Festival, national flag-hoisting ceremony etc.

Last but not least, our school believes that all our teachers will be devoted to building up the students' Chinese ability and we hope students can enjoy their Chinese learning experience.





English

Our students' English education starts with their reading skills in lower primary. In primary one to three, we equip them with phonics, sight words, and comprehension skills, and expose them to diverse age-appropriate books and genres. To nurture their reading abilities, teachers inculcate various strategies like reading aloud, shared reading, guided reading, and group activities. These techniques not only infuse imagination and creativity in the students but also foster their interest in literature.

The upper primary curriculum aims to enhance students' writing proficiency by building on their basic reading skills. During primary four to six, emphasis is placed on developing their grammar, vocabulary, and sentence construction abilities to create coherent and impactful written works. Teachers use activities such as storyboarding, brainstorming, and self/peer editing to make writing enjoyable and creative. This allows children to experiment with different writing styles and language usage.





The school curriculum places a significant emphasis on language arts, which is crucial in providing students with the necessary skills and tools to enhance their communication, critical thinking, and self-expression abilities. Our school actively engages students in public poetry reading contests, inter-school drama competitions, and short film competitions to foster their expressive abilities in a coherent and meaningful way. These activities encourage students to explore their thoughts and ideas with clarity and structure, promoting effective communication.



Mathematics

In order to strengthen students' ability to integrate and apply knowledge and skills, Maths Department arranges different activities for students every year.



Visual Arts










Library


